The unit work is:

To establish and monitor the correct diagnosis of infection with the best turn-around time (TAT), and the proper antimicrobial utilization in the hospital, in line with the six operational pillars prescribed by the State (Operational Plan, Committee, Committee Meetings, Antibiogram, Institutional Antibiotic Policy, and Antibiotic Use Monitoring). The Committee will meet at least once every month, or at minimum once every quarter.

Terms of Reference:

- Develop, notify and periodically update the facility-level AMSP Operational Plan, including a restricted-antibiotic list and antibiotic order forms.
- Convene Committee meetings monthly/quarterly and maintain signed Minutes of Meeting.
- Prepare a biannual/annual antibiogram and maintain monthly antimicrobial-resistance trend data through the Department of Microbiology.
- Develop/update the Institutional Antibiotic Policy based on the latest antibiogram and AWARe classification.
- Conduct a biannual/annual antibiotic consumption study, prescription audit and/or Point Prevalence Survey (PPS).
- Undertake prospective audit with intervention and feedback; recommend formulary restriction/pre-authorization for reserved antibiotics where required.
- Forward the Office Order, Operational Plan, Minutes, Antibiogram and consumption reports to GUJSAR/GUJSAC-Net as required by the State.
